Tuition Conditions

All fees stated below are for weekly lessons delivered by specialist staff during the designated Co-curricular teaching periods. These fees also take into consideration that lessons will not be held on public holidays or on days where compulsory school events occur.

Piano lessons are available as Individual lessons only. Guitar/Bass lessons are offered as Individual or Paired lessons only. Availability of all lesson types - Individual, Pair, Group are subject to availability and student numbers.

Co-curricular tuition fees are payable quarterly, through Parent Lounge and are due by the end of Week 2 each term. **A minimum of one term's notice is required for lesson cancellation.**

Students are expected to commit to their lessons and ensembles for the full school year.

Participation by students in the College's Co-curricular Music Program is contingent on school fees for that student being up to date or with an agreed payment plan to settle any outstanding debts in place.

By submitting the Co-curricular Music Tuition form or accepting the invite via Parent Lounge you are agreeing to these conditions.

Additional Information

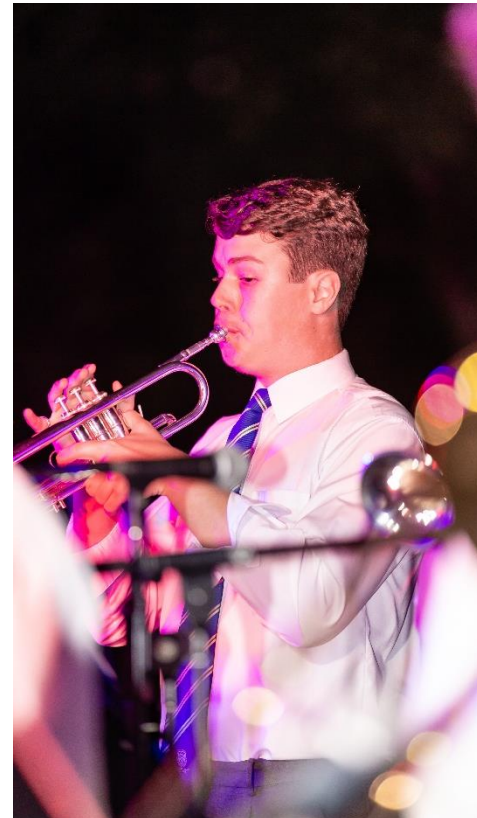
- Involvement in the ATC Choral Program does not incur any fee
- Instruments available for hire through the College have a \$318 per annum servicing fee
- Senior Ensemble students are required to purchase a music folder for \$20, lost folders will incur an additional fee
- Piano students will need to have access to a piano or digital piano with weighted keys, for home practice
- Students may be required to purchase additional materials such as method books or examination resources
- Unless notice is provided to the Music Department by 8am on the day of the lesson, missed lessons will not be made up or refunded

Years 4 - 11 Students in ATC Ensemble Program

Students who receive either individual, paired, or small group tuition are encouraged to participate in core and extension instrumental ensembles. Rehearsals are run weekly with musical directors and support staff and offer various opportunities to perform including QCMF, Summer, Autumn and Formal Music Concerts.

Terms and Conditions

Lessons

- All fees stated in the Fees Schedule are for weekly lessons delivered by specialist staff during the designated Co-curricular teaching periods with the provision of a minimum of thirty-two lessons per year.
- The individual Music Tutor will arrange lesson times. Timetables will be emailed to parents at the beginning of each Term and posted to the relevant Tag on the ATC College App.
- It is the responsibility of the student to check their lesson time via the College App. If students have a clash with their lesson time, they are encouraged to negotiate a more suitable time with their Music Tutor as early as possible.
- Although every attempt is made to keep lesson times the same day from week to week, lesson times often change due to public holidays and other College activities. Generally, lesson times will be on a rotational structure to ensure the same academic lessons are not missed each week.
- Piano lessons are available as individual lessons only. Guitar/Bass lessons are offered as individual or paired lessons only. Availability of all lesson types - Individual, Pair, Group are subject to availability and student numbers.

Absentees

- Lessons missed by students without prior notice will not be rescheduled, with the cost of the lesson forfeited. In the event of illness, email the Music Tutor directly and cc music@atc.qld.edu.au by 7.30am, this will allow the Music Tutor time to arrange a make-up lesson.
- Where a student misses a lesson as a result of a College event (e.g. an excursion or an exam), notice by the student needs to be given to the tutor in advance to allow time to reschedule the lesson.
- Missed lessons without notice, for any reason other than illness will not be made up or refunded.

Fee payment

- Co-curricular Music and Drama & Communication tuition fees are payable in four payments in Terms 1, 2, 3 and 4. They are due within 7 days of receipt of payment notice.
- All payments are to be made through Parent Lounge under Events & Payments.
- Participation by students in the ATC Co-curricular Music Program is contingent on school fees for that student being up to date or with an agreed payment plan in place.

Termination of Lessons

- Students are expected to commit to their lessons and ensembles for the full school year.
- Where a student elects to terminate lessons during the year, notice of termination must be provided in writing by the end of the school term prior to the term of termination. Where notification of withdrawal has not been received by the parent or caregiver by the end of a term, payment will be required in full for the following term, even if the student does not attend lessons.
